CAPTAINS MEETING

April 17, 2017

The Meeting of the Team Captains of the Cleveland Industrial Golf League was held at Clubhouse at Grand Bay on Monday, April 17, 2017. Meeting Minutes were respectively taken by Secretary Daryl Smith.

- 1. President Jim Bilek called the meeting to order at 6:31pm. Roll call taken, all teams were represented except for OCS Technologies, QDM and Tendon Manufacturing.
- 2. Meeting Minutes: Minutes from the Captains meeting on April 3, 2017 were presented and reviewed. Motion to accept by Ted Bush, seconded by Adam Hill. Approved.
- 3. Finance Report: Treasurer Jeff Kregenow reported a balance of \$3,439.15 in the league's account which includes the last of the funds transferred from former Treasurer Daryl DuBroy. Two teams, QDM and Tendon Manufacturing, have not paid their team fees for 2017. Team fees are \$200 per team and \$50 per player for 2017. President Bilek again stressed that no teams are eligible for prize money until team fees are paid and cannot be won retroactively, once prizes are awarded they are awarded.
- 4. Handicap Chairman: Chairman David Hill reported and commented on the following:
 - Tee designations for all players will be set based on the information found in the rosters submitted by the team captains.
 - Since Shale Creek is a shotgun start and to expedite computer usage, David has offered to pre-load lineups for the event if he receives the team's lineup via email from the captains no later than 5PM on Wednesday, April 26,20017.
 - To qualify for the Match Play Tournament each player must play one of the first three events of the year (Turkeyfoot, Shale Creek, Windmill) with their first event played casting their qualifying score.
 - David reported 17 new players have been added to the league membership, 9 with estimated indexes and 8 with actual scores.
 - David also reported the laptop used at the courses to record scores has an old operating system on it, Windows XP, and eventually will need to be replaced. He believes the league will be able to get through this year's activities and suggests the league consider a new laptop before the 2018 season.
- 5. Rules Chairman: Chairman Bob Grosh had nothing to report.
- 6. Schedule Chairmen: Chairman Jim Bilek reported the following:
 - The head-to-head schedule has been set and every attempt was made to balance or average the frequency of each team being the first team off each week. It proved difficult to have all 11 teams with the same average starting position given the schedule had two shotgun starts and two spilt tee starts. As it was 8 of the 11 teams had the same average starting position.
 - Jim is still waiting on Shale Creek to provide him where the league will start given it is a shotgun start. Jim has tried to contact Shale on the phone and in person with no luck. Jim will continue to follow up with them to get a breakdown of which holes the league will start on and how many groups will start on each hole.
 - Sugar Bush start time has been moved from 7:30 to 7:36.
 - Windmill (Open event) start time has been move from 7:26 to 7:12.
 - Jim mentioned he believes Hawthorn Valley (who has recently partnered with Davey Tree) would be a great course for the league to play next year. Consideration will be given at the appropriate time.
