CAPTAINS MEETING

September 5, 2017

The Meeting of the Team Captains of the Cleveland Industrial Golf League was held at the Clubhouse at Grand Bay on Tuesday, September 5, 2017. Meeting minutes taken by Secretary Daryl Smith.

- 1. President Jim Bilek called the meeting to order at 6:30pm. Roll call taken, all teams were represented except for DLH and Keystone.
- 2. Meeting Minutes: Minutes from the Captains meeting on August 7, 2017 were presented and reviewed. Motion to accept by Bob Grosh, seconded by Bob Heiss. Approved.
- 3. Finance Report: Treasurer Jeff Kregenow was unable to attend. President Bilek reported a balance of approximately \$10,325 in the leagues' account. It appears sufficient funds exist for the league to fund the Awards Dinner with only a small stipend needed from each member attending the dinner.
- 4. Handicap Chairman: Handicap Chairman David Hill had nothing to report.
- 5. Rules Committee: Chairman Bob Grosh had nothing to report.
- 6. Schedule: Chairmen Jim Bilek reported the following:
 - The CIGL Cup / Team Finals / Fun Day will be held at Brookledge on Saturday, September 9, 2017 with the first tee time at 7:24am.
 - Jim asked the captains if the league is willing to return to Madison in 2018 under the same circumstances as this year: 9am start with six sets of tee times. The captains accepted the conditions as no objections were noted.
 - 2018 schedule is 75% confirmed. Two dates remain open. Possible new options are Chardon Lakes, Boulder Creek, and Hawthorne Valley. Draft of the 2018 schedule will be made available at the Awards Dinner.
 - 2018 schedule looks as if Sanctuary will either be the last Open event or a Knockdown, Round 1 of Playoffs at Windmill Lakes, Round 2 of Playoffs at Seven Hills, and the Finals at Brookledge.
 - Three courses are out for 2018, Ellsworth Meadows, Mohican Hills, and Barberton Brookside.
 - For the 2019 schedule, efforts will be made to schedule one of the Cleveland Metro Park courses.
 - Bob Heiss recommended Grey Hawk be given consideration for a possible return. He said the course is under new management and the course is in great shape.
 - Eric Sandvick recommended Valley of the Eagles (formerly Spring Valley) in Elyria as a possible course for 2019. He played it recently and thought it would be a great course for the league.

8. New Business:

- Games/fees/comments discussed for the Finals at Brookledge.
 - Tee times will be arranged with Open times first followed by the Team Finals with the league officers going off last. (No tee times for the Match Play finals are needed this year since the winners have already been determined.)
 - o \$10 2 Man "Pink" Ball (\$5 per player) up to three entries but only within their own foursome. All entrants must sign in at the table with each team declaring which player will

play the odd number holes and which one the even numbered holes. A "pink" ball will be assigned and must be returned to the table in the clubhouse after the round. The winners will be determined by determining the net scores by adding all even/odd holes assigned for all teams returning their "pink" ball. Those playing in the Team Finals do not have to play the "pink" ball but will be expected to use the honor system should their own ball be lost on the hole where they are the designated player.

- o Floor opened to all team captains to slot their players into their respective tee times.
- A comment was made suggesting that yardages of playoff courses did not justify the adjustments
 made to the handicaps of the players using the front tee boxes. After several minutes of discussion
 President Bilek promised to compile and analyze the yardage difference between the front and
 regular tees so it can be determined what, if any, changes can be put forth at the next Winter
 Captains Meeting. President Bilek did comment that the league will be looking at possible criteria
 that must be met to permit a player to use the front tee boxes and if the league should reduce the
 minimum yardage for the front tees.
