CAPTAIN'S MEETING

APRIL 16, 2018

The Meeting of the Team Captains of the Cleveland Industrial Golf League was held at the Clubhouse at Grand Bay on Monday, April 16, 2018. In the absence of Secretary Daryl Smith, minutes were taken by Treasurer Jeff Kregenow.

- 1. President Jim Bilek Called the meeting to order at 6:30 AM. Roll call was taken, all teams were represented except for NetBirdies.com.
- <u>Meeting Minutes</u>: Minutes of the Captains meeting held on March 26, 2018 were reviewed and amended. Treasurer's report in the minutes stated league had a balance of balance of \$5,913, when the actual balance was \$591.13. Motion to accept as amended by Adam Hill, seconded by Brian Seman, Approved.
- 3. <u>Treasurers Report:</u> Treasurer Kregenow reported a current balance of \$4,241.13, with 4 teams having paid their fees for the 2018 season. Captain Ray Mach has informed the treasurer he will be dropping off the check for Keystone on Wednesday. Motion to accept by Adam Hill, seconded by Brian Seman, Treasurer's Report approved.
- Handicap Chairman's Report: David Hill reports that we have 152 players this year, with 30 on the front tees, 121 on the middle, and 1 on the back. The current split for classes is AA 0-9, A 10-13, B 14-16, and C 17-36. Motion to accept by Adam Hill, seconded by Brian Seman, Handicap Chairman's report is approved.
- 5. <u>Rules:</u> Bob Grosh has nothing to report on at this time.
- 6. <u>Schedule</u>: Bilek reports that all courses have been finalized for 2018, with some last minute changes. Boulder Creek lost our booking information and has 2 large outing's that day, so we will now be playing at Mohican Hills, with a shotgun start at 8:15 AM. Bilek reports that we have more shotgun and front/back starts than usual.
- 7. <u>Old Business:</u> Bilek reminds that Match Play qualifier can be any of the first three weeks, need to let Bilek or David Hill know prior to qualifying in weeks 2 or 3. Discussion concerning playing provisional ball for possibility of ball in hazard can be done for pace of play reasons. Vice President Murphy asks if pre-played match play matches are now to be counted for handicap purposes, can those scores count for 72-hole event if played on the open event course. Bilek cautions that playing conditions are not the same. Murphy declines to make a proposal.
