

CLEVELAND INDUSTRIAL GOLF LEAGUE

CAPTAINS MEETING

September 10, 2018

The Meeting of the Team Captains of the Cleveland Industrial Golf League was held at the Clubhouse at Grand Bay on Monday, September 10, 2018. Meeting minutes taken by Secretary Daryl Smith.

1. President Jim Bilek called the meeting to order at 6:30pm. Roll call taken, all teams were represented except for Mike's Tree Service, NetBirdies.com and Tendon Manufacturing.
2. Meeting Minutes: Minutes from the Captains meeting on August 6, 2018 were presented and reviewed. Motion to accept by Charlie Fields, seconded by Ted Bush. Approved.
3. Finance Report: Treasurer Jeff Kregenow reported a balance of \$10,031.52 in the leagues' account and reflects expenditures for compensation to the Handicap Chairman / Website Coordinator, payment to Hawk's Nest for food/drink coupons, payment to Geek Squad for computer needs and receipts from Hawk Nest's Blind Bogey. Motion to accept by Adam Hill, seconded by Ted Bush. Approved.
4. Handicap Chairman: Handicap Chairman David Hill reported the following:
 - Once again it was mentioned the Skins envelopes must be put in the Skins lockbox to be eligible to win any Skins. Placing the envelope back in the holder where all the empty envelopes are found will not make the player eligible as was the case recently.
 - Entering Scores. REMINDER: If a player does not finish a hole an "X" should be entered in as the score for the hole and the computer will handle it. The computer will either double or triple bogey the missing score(s) depending on the player's handicap for index calculation purposes. If a player does not show up for his round do not put in a score for that player, the computer will recognize it and handle accordingly.
 - A recap of what transpired at Sanctuary with the very first group was given. The first group exceeded the 4:35 time limit and offered no explanation or comments. The Handicap Chair explained his decision to enforce the slow-play penalty on the foursome with no subjective bias. The group had the ability to appeal to the board but no appeal was made. Ted Bush summarized his views. Bob Grosh brought up what he experienced at Sanctuary as did Rick Saunders and a couple of other captains with regard to the other outing at the course causing the slow play. Captain Rick Saunders made a motion to rescind the penalties due to the unusual situation at Sanctuary. Motion seconded by Adam Hill. Motion passed 7-2. The penalty will be removed from the four players.
5. Rules Committee: Chairman Bob Grosh reported.
 - What is the penalty for playing the wrong ball out of a hazard (water hazard or bunker)? The player incurs a penalty of two strokes. The stroke played with the wrong ball does not count in his score for the hole. The player must correct the error

by playing out the hole with the correct ball. If the player is unable to find his original ball he must proceed under the lost ball rule.

- What is the penalty for playing from the wrong tee box? Since Match play rules supersedes Medal play rules the opponent may immediately require the player to cancel the stroke and play a ball from the correct tee box otherwise it is play-on.

6. Schedule: Chairmen Jim Bilek reported the following:

- Status of Sawmill is still up in the air for a possible sale so the league will not return next year during the regular season.
- Tam O'Shanter is still open but will watch for a possible closing since they are on the 2019 schedule.
- Finalized Manakiki for next year at \$50-57 greens fees and an 8am tee time.

8. New Business:

- Games/fees/comments discussed for the Brookledge Finals event.
 - 8AM - First tee time
 - \$10 - 2 Man "Pink" Ball (\$5 per player) - up to three entries but only within their own foursome. All entrants must sign in at the table with each team declaring which player will play the odd number holes and which one the even numbered holes. A "pink" ball will be assigned and must be returned to the table in the clubhouse after the round. The winners will be determined by determining the net scores by adding all even/odd holes assigned for all teams returning their "pink" ball. Those playing in the Team Finals do not have to play the "pink" ball but will be expected to use the honor system should their own ball be lost on the hole where they are the designated player.
 - Individual Low Net - League sponsored.
 - \$10 - Skins Game - Two classes
 - No Blind Bogey.
 - Starters - David Hill and xR
 - Long drive and Closet to the Pin holes to be determined.
 - Two sets of boxes will be used, Front (Blue) and Regular (Black).
 - Captains have until 5pm Thursday, September 13, 2018 to notify the Handicap Chairman of any tee time deletions.
 - Jim Bilek will arrive early to manage the tee markers.
 - Open play will be first off the tees followed by the Match Play finals with the Team Match last.
 - Floor opened to all team captains to slot their players into their respective tee times.
 - SPECIAL NOTES CONCERNING BROOKLEDGE:
 - Brookledge had to aerate the greens for holes #3, 4, 7, 10 due to environmental concerns. The hope is the rain this week will heal them.
 - Hole #2 - Left side of hole will be played as a hazard.
 - Hole #12 - The drop area for the hole is the front tee box. If there is a drop area located next to the green it should not be used.

- Adam Hill asked the league to look at possibly changing the scoring system and dropping the low net points within the team matches from 8 points to 6 which would put a bit more emphasis on the hole match points. It will be considered at the winter meeting next year.
9. Announcements: The next meeting will be the banquet at Buffalo Wild Wings at Westgate a time to be determined.
10. Motion to adjourn by Ted Bush, seconded by David Hill. Meeting adjourned at 8:07pm.
